- The Agreement signed by UniSR and GMU on July 9, 2020 for International Mobility at GMU of UniSR students enrolled to the International MD Program (IMDP) and the relevant Addenda;
- The Rector's Decrees n. 9853 and n. 9854 governing the Call for admissions for the IMDP Academic Year 2026/2027

Art. 1 - Presentation

Through the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed by Vita-Salute San Raffaele University (UniSR) and Gulf Medical University (GMU) in Ajman – UAE on April 9, 2019, the two institutions agree on the utility and importance of establishing cultural, scientific and educational relationships.

In this respect, UniSR e GMU recognize each other as eligible centers for promotion and development of cooperation in the field of health and biomedical assistance, research, innovation and education.

The agreement regarding International Mobility at GMU signed on July 9, 2020 by UniSR and GMU, together with the relevant Addenda, envisages and regulates the possibility for UniSR students, enrolled to the International MD Program, to attend the first three years at GMU by enrolling in the Higher Diploma in Preclinical Sciences program (hereinafter referred to as HDPCS), and obtaining the HDPCS certificate, issued by Gulf Medical University, at the end of the program.

In consideration of the foregoing, this Mobility Announcement is published and regulates selection and admittance for the three-year mobility program at Gulf Medical University for 20 students enrolled to the first year of the International MD Program for the academic year 2026/2027.

Art. 2 - Places available

For the Academic Year 2026/2027, the places available for the mobility program at **Gulf Medical University** are **20**.

European and Non-European students, **who have been admitted for enrolment** for the AY 2026/2027 in the International MD Program, can apply for the mobility program.

Enrolment in the UniSR International MD Program is a mandatory prerequisite for accessing the mobility program with GMU.

Admission to the International MD Program for the Academic Year 2026/2027 is regulated by the relevant Chancellor's Decrees.

The aforementioned Decrees indicate requirements, admission methods and deadlines, the making of the ranking lists, enrolment details and deadlines, documents requested and university fees. Reference is made to these Decrees for all details concerning selection, admission and enrolment to the IMDP.

Art. 3 - How to apply

Candidates admitted to the International MD Program and interested in participating to the mobility program at GMU must send the specific form (Annex 1) via email at admissions@univr.it. The application may be sent in parallel with the procedures for the admission to the International MD Program.

As submitting the application, candidates can proceed with enrolment to the HDPCS Program directly on

the dedicated page of GMU's website. Applications for participation may be submitted until the number of places is covered and, in any case, no later than the deadlines indicated by GMU.

Art. 4 – Requirements and selection method

Admission Requirements for Higher Diploma in Pre-Clinical Sciences (HDPCS) Program are those established by GMU and available on GMU's website: <https://gmu.ac.ae/college-medicine/higher-diploma-in-pre-clinical-sciences-hdpcs/>

Art. 5 – Application feedback

Admission of candidates is subject to the conditions of approval from GMU. GMU can, in any moment and with a motivated provision, reject the application due to the lack of requirements.

Candidates will receive notice on the outcome of their application for admission to the HDPCS directly from GMU. Successful candidates will be admitted to the HDPCS until all places available are covered.

If admitted and within 7 days from receipt of a positive feedback, candidates who intend to accept their place in the HDPCS, must send the Acceptance form (Annex 2) at admissions@univr.it.

In the same way, these candidates must comply within the terms and deadlines given by GMU for confirming and enrolling in the HDPCS once admission is confirmed.

Failure to confirm either to GMU or to UniSR will be considered as a renouncement.

Admitted candidates who do not wish to accept their assigned place in the HDPCS at GMU must send their declaration of renunciation (annex 3) to admissions@univr.it.

Art. 6 – Enrolment

Candidates admitted to the mobility program at GMU and who intend to enrol in the HDPCS, must in any case complete enrolment in the International MD Program complying with the regulations and within the deadlines indicated in the Call for admission to the IMDP Program AY 2026/2027.

Candidates admitted to the mobility program will be therefore enrolled both at UniSR and GMU for the three years of the HDPCS.

Students are personally responsible for obtaining the documentation necessary for participating in the mobility program and must hand it in to the Universities upon request and/or upon arrival at each University.

Art. 7 - University fees and further expenses

Students admitted to the mobility program and enrolling in the HDPCS must pay the university fees to GMU as envisaged for the HDPCS.

No payment will be requested from UniSR to the student for the first three years of mobility apart from governmental and regional taxes for enrolment (€190,00 + €16,00).

Starting from the 4th year, students enrolled in the International MD Program who are returning from the mobility period at GMU, will pay the fees due for the International MD Program corresponding to the amount defined by the Board of Directors for the academic year of reference.

In all cases, and if envisaged by the university, students will be requested to pay final certifications/diplomas issuance taxes and delivery costs.

Personal expenses, such as but not limited to, travel, accommodation, transportation, medical insurance, maintenance of accommodation, books and academic material and any other expense that may arise during the permanence in one or the other university will be entirely upon the student.

Art. 8 - Scholarship

Students will have the right to participate in the competition for the Regional scholarship ('Regione Lombardia') under the conditions established by the relevant Call. Any university fees paid to GMU do not fall within the conditions set in the Scholarship regulations ('Diritto allo Studio').

Art. 9 - Attendance and release of transcripts

Admitted students will comply with the regulations concerning attendance to lessons and exams as established by each University.

Students admitted to the mobility program and enrolled to the HDPCS at GMU will receive their academic records at the end of the 1st and 2nd year.

Students admitted to the mobility program and enrolled to the HDPCS at GMU will receive their academic records of the 3rd year *only* upon completion of all the exams required for obtaining the Higher Diploma in Preclinical Sciences final certificate.

Students who intend to continue their studies at UniSR starting from year 4 must have successfully completed all courses and exams envisaged by the HDPCS at GMU.

As a mandatory requirement, students must also submit a B1 level (CEFR) certificate of Italian language upon enrolment in year 4 at UniSR.

Failing to submit the Italian language certificate would result in the student's ineligibility for enrolment in year 4 at UniSR.

In order to be able to issue their academic qualifications, both universities are required to comply with

each country's regulations concerning enrolment of international students. Therefore, candidates may be required to meet additional pre-enrolment requirements as established by each of the two universities, in order to participate in the program.

Art. 10 – Evaluation and recognition of credits

The study program of the HDPCS is comparable to the first three years of the International MD Program. The validation of credits is established and detailed in the Agreement between GMU and UniSR reserved to students enrolled in the UniSR International MD Program, signed on July 9, 2020 and in the relevant Addenda.

Art. 11 – Insurance coverage and safety

Students participating to the mobility period at GMU will be covered for non-professional Civil Liability and accidents directly by GMU.

All Students will comply with, and respect customs and regulations, including those for Health and Safety, in use in each University.

Art. 12 – Withdrawal or exclusion

a) Withdrawal before the beginning of the HDPCS program and/or exclusion from the program:

Students admitted to the HDPCS course can renounce to their assigned place for the mobility **before the start of the program** by filling in the dedicated form (Annex 3) and sending it via e-mail at admissions@univr.it. The admitted student must also comply with GMU's deadlines for confirming or renouncing to the assigned place.

Both the renouncing student and the student who is eventually deemed not eligible for the mobility program, will be allowed to attend the International MD Program at UniSR starting from year 1 by paying the enrolment fee and as per the terms set forth in the International MD Program call for admission for the academic year **2026/2027**.

b) Ongoing withdrawal

Any student who decides to renounce to the mobility period at GMU before completion of the three years and to continue their studies at UniSR, will be allowed to apply for career recognition at UniSR by sending formal request to the International MD Program's Academic Board and enrolling in the corresponding year as decided by the Board.
