

## Appendix UniSR Residences Re-entry procedure starting from September 2021

Starting from September 1, and in compliance with the existing provisions and the indications set forth in the document 'UniSR Green Pass Guidelines', for further safety of our students, **access** and permanence in the **University Residences** will be permitted only for those in **possession of the COVID-19 Green Certification** (i.e. Green Pass).

This means that **in order to access and reside** in the UniSR Residences, every student must possess a valid Green Pass (or equivalent certificate as envisaged by the law) which can be verified on a daily basis by the staff in charge.

Below is the procedure which all students (renewals or new admissions) who intend to access the University Residence Melghera and the University Residence Cassinella must follow:

## 1. Email requesting entrance to the Residences:

Students must send an email requesting permission to enter the Residences at least **3 days prior to their arrival date** to the following addresses:

In the email, students must attach copy of the **Affidavit admission to the UniSR Residences Rev.6** (<a href="https://www.unisr.it/ateneo/info-covid19/residenze">https://www.unisr.it/ateneo/info-covid19/residenze</a>) duly filled out and signed and they must also indicate the following information:

- o Expected date of arrival in the Residence
- o If envisaged, the need to carry out the mandatory self-quarantine in the Residence (when arriving from abroad); In this case the student undertakes to carry out the isolation period in the assigned room without accessing the common areas of the residence and according to the modalities envisaged in the Residence Guidelines.

The possibility of isolating in the Residences for students arriving from abroad must be authorized by UniSR beforehand.

Upon entering the Residences, Students must hand the original copy of the **Affidavit admission** to the UniSR Residences Rev.6 (https://www.unisr.it/ateneo/info-covid19/residenze) duly filled out and signed.



## 2. Green Pass

Before entering the Residences, a complete copy of the valid Green pass or equivalent certificate as envisaged by the law, must be sent to the email address <a href="mailto:greenpass@unisr.it">greenpass@unisr.it</a>. This email address is managed by **Preventive Medicine Service** only, according to the indications of the law and to the privacy regulations.
