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Having seen the by-laws of Vita-Salute San Raffaele University, approved with the decree of the Italian Minister for Universities, Scientific Research and Technology of 2 August 1996, as amended;

Having seen Legislative Decree no. 68 of 29 March 2012 *“Review of the legislation establishing the principles for the right to education and the proper operation of legally recognised university colleges”*;

Having seen Prime Ministerial Decree dated 9 April 2001 *“Provisions for uniformity regarding the assistance of university students, pursuant to art. 4 of law no. 390 of 2 December 1991”*;

Having seen Regional Law no. 33 of 13 December 2004 *“Regulations for regional measures for the assistance of university students”*;

Having seen Prime Ministerial Decree no. 159 of 5 December 2013 *“Regulations governing the calculation and fields of application of the Economic Status Indicator (ISEE)”*, as amended;

Having seen the Memorandum of Agreement signed on 19 July 2010 between the Lombardy Region and the Ministry of Education, Universities and Research;

Having seen Law n. 240 of 30 December 2010, *“Regulations on the organisation of universities, academic staff and recruitment, as well as authorisation for the Government to incentivise the quality and efficiency of the university system” and art. 5, comma 6 in particular*;

Having seen the Ministerial Decree no. 176 of February 24, 2026, *“Establishment of the list of especially poor countries for the academic year 2026/2027”*;

Having seen Law no. 241 of 7 August 1990, as amended *“New regulations governing administrative procedures and right of access to administrative documents”*;

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Having seen Law no. 338 of 14 November 2000 as amended, *“Measures regarding accommodation and halls of residence for university students”*;

Having seen the Vita-Salute San Raffaele University Halls of Residence Regulations approved by the Board of Directors on 2 March 2015;

Having seen the agreement between the Lombardy Region and Vita-Salute San Raffaele University of Milan for the provision of assistance to university students, signed on 29 January 2024;

Having seen Ministerial Decree no. 1320 of 17 December 2021 *“Increase in the value of scholarships and eligibility requirements for financial assistance for university students”*;

Having seen Circular no. 13676 of 11 May 2022, issued pursuant to art. 6, comma 1 of Ministerial Decree no. 1320 of 17 December 2021;

Having seen Lombardy Regional Council Resolution no. XII/6298 of 15 June 2026, containing *“Resolutions regarding criteria and funding for the award of financial assistance to university students on the basis of rankings, 2026/2027 academic year”*.

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I HEREBY ORDER
THE PUBLICATION OF THE CALL FOR APPLICATIONS
FOR BENEFITS FOR THE RIGHT TO HIGHER EDUCATION
ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027

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Benefits for the right to higher education offered in the competition call are:

- scholarships, grants for participation in international exchange programmes and free meals for eligible scholarship students/beneficiary students;
- accommodation service at reduced fee.

In accordance with art. 8 of the Prime Ministerial Decree dated 9 April 2001 and Legislative Decree 68/2012, all the eligible beneficiary scholarship students and the eligible students not beneficiary of scholarships due to lack of funds are exempt from payment of the enrolment fee and tuition fees, except for students enrolled at the first supplementary year, who are exempt from payment of half the university fees.

Students whose scholarship entitlement is revoked for any reason also lose their right to exemption from payment of the enrolment fee and tuition fees and are required to pay the amounts due as envisaged by art. 9 of this call for applications.

FIRST SECTION

SCHOLARSHIPS

ARTICLE 1. NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Number of Scholarships offered for students enrolled at Vita-Salute San Raffaele University for the 2026/2027 academic year:

- n. 39** scholarships for students enrolled in the first year of a Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree or Single-Cycle Master's Degree course for the first time;
- n. 98** scholarships for students enrolled in a subsequent year than the first of a Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree or Single-Cycle Master's Degree course;
- n. 3** scholarships for students enrolled in PhD courses if not beneficiary of a scholarship or of a research grant, and in Specialisation courses (excluding medical specialisation courses covered by Legislative Decree 368/99);
- n. 5** scholarship supplements including refund of travel expenses for participation in international exchange programmes.

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The total number of scholarships and international exchange scheme supplements may be raised in case of any additional funding assigned by the Lombardy Region, the Ministry of Universities and Research, the University or other public or private institutions.

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ARTICLE 2. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER THE COMPETITION CALL

The call for applications is open to Italian students, European Member State students and Non-EU students, in accordance with Presidential Decree no. 394 of 31 August 1999, implementing Legislative Decree no. 286 of 25 July 1998.

In order to be considered for a scholarship students must be enrolled or declare their intention of enrolling:

- 1) for the first time, in a standard year of a Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree or Single-Cycle Master's Degree course;
- 2) for an additional year over and above those envisaged by the relevant didactic regulations after completing the standard course of study for a Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree or Single-Cycle Master's Degree course;
- 3) in a PhD course (if not beneficiary of a scholarship or a research grant);
- 4) in a Specialization course (excluding those in the medical area).

Students with a certified disability of at least 66% or above or registered as disabled under art. 3, comma 1 of Law no. 104 of 5 February 1992, enrolled for a further two years after completion of the standard course of study for a Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree or Single-Cycle Master's Degree course, are also eligible.

During the 2026/2027 academic year, students must not:

- 1) hold an educational qualification, awarded in Italy or abroad, equal or superior in level to the course for which the scholarship for the 2026/2027 academic year is applied for;
- 2) receive another scholarship from Vita-Salute San Raffaele University or any other public or private institution for the same year of their degree program.

Students will also be excluded from the rankings for the award of scholarships if during the 2026/2027 academic year:

- 1) they re-enrol after withdrawing from their program;
- 2) they are repeating students in intermediate years of the program;
- 3) they switch Faculty or degree Course with the obligation to repeat a year already attended;
- 4) they transfer between universities with the obligation to re-enrol for a year already attended.

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If, during their university career, a student has had to repeat the same academic year – whether due to re-enrollment following a formal withdrawal from studies or for any other reason – the number of credits required for scholarship rankings is calculated with reference to the credits available in each year, starting from their **initial year of enrolment in any course**, also including the academic years in which they have repeated a course year.

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ARTICLE 3. PREREQUISITES TO ENTER THE RANKINGS

In order to be eligible for the definitive rankings, applicants must be properly enrolled for the 2026/2027 academic year as of 30 November 2026 and must meet the academic merit and income requirements set out below.

For verification of the deadline for enrolment for Master's Degree, PhD and Specialisation courses, reference is made to the provisions of the current regulations of Vita-Salute San Raffaele University.

Academic merit qualifications

- a) students enrolled for the first time **in the first year of a Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree or Single-Cycle Master's Degree course** are required to hold a high school diploma with mark of at least **80/100** and must be properly enrolled for their course. Academic merit will be assessed retrospectively and is determined in accordance with article 9 of this call for applications;
- b) students enrolled for the first time **in the first year of a Master's Degree course** must be properly enrolled for their course. Academic merit will be assessed retrospectively and is determined in accordance with article 9 of this call for applications;
- c) for students enrolled in **PhD courses** (if not recipients of scholarship or research grant) and **Specialization courses** (excluding those in the medical area referred to in D. Lgs. 368/99), the merit requirements correspond to those necessary for admission to the relevant course year;
- d) students registered **for a subsequent year than the first year of Bachelor's, Master's and Single-Cycle Master's Degree courses** must be properly enrolled and must have achieved the number of ECTS-credits set out below by **10 August 2026**:

- **Bachelor's Degree Courses:**

Year 2: 49 ECTS-credits

Year 3: 95 ECTS-credits

Last semester (1st year beyond prescribed time): 150 ECTS-credits

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- **Single-Cycle Master's Degree Courses:**

Year 2: 49 ECTS-credits

Year 3: 95 ECTS-credits

Year 4: 160 ECTS-credits

Year 5: 215 ECTS-credits

Year 6: 270 ECTS-credits

Last semester (1st year beyond prescribed time): 330 ECTS-credits

- **Master's Degree Courses:**

Year 2: 45 ECTS-credits

Last semester (1st year beyond prescribed time): 90 ECTS-credits

*The minimum number of ECTS-credits for **Master's Degree courses** is increased by a number of credits equal to the number in excess of 180, which may be recognised to the student at the time of enrolment.*

ECTS-credits for examinations taken in order to recoup educational deficits are not considered in the above totals.

The results of the final examinations of internships undertaken and positive pass of professional activities carried out, for reasons relating to the university's own organisational planning, after 10 August 2026 will be considered valid, provided the results of the said examinations are registered by 31 October 2026.

For disabled students, academic merit qualifications which vary by no more than 40% those specified above may be set. Academic merit qualifications will be established by a specific commission, with advice from the teacher appointed to support the diversely able students concerned.

Important: the number of ECTS-credits necessary for admission to the ranking is calculated on the basis of the ECTS-credits available for each academic year, starting from the very first year of matriculation, and thus also including academic years in which a student repeated the same year of enrolment, also in different Degree courses attended previously, for any reason, such as withdrawal, transfer or switching between Degree courses. In accordance with art. 6, comma 8, of Prime Ministerial Decree dated 9 April 2001, only the ECTS-credits awarded for the course for which the funding is applied for are considered, on the basis of the didactic regulations for the course and the relative criteria.

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Any surplus credits (more than those required or from outside the course curriculum), such as those not valid for award of the degree, and those of graduation exam or equivalent, are excluded from the overall academic merit calculation.

Bonus

Students enrolled in a subsequent year than the first year of Bachelor's and Single-Cycle Master's Degree courses are assigned a bonus which they may use, just once during the course of study, to make up any differences between the minimum number of ECTS-credits required and the credits they have actually gained. The size of the bonus varies depending on the year of enrolment in which the student decides to use it. Specifically, the bonus totals:

- **5 credits** if used for the first time to obtain benefits for the second academic year;
- **12 credits** if used for the first time to obtain benefits for the third academic year;
- **15 credits** if used for the first time to obtain benefits for subsequent academic years.

The bonus can only be used **once** and is not cumulative; it is irrevocably defined in the scholarship application. The part of the bonus not used in any given academic year can be used in subsequent years. The bonus accrued and not used in the Bachelor's Degree course can be used if the student enrolls for Master's Degree courses. This rule does not apply to students enrolled on Master's Degree courses established under the old regulations.

Students who obtained their Bachelor's Degree from another University must submit suitable documentation proving the number of "bonus" credits accrued and not used.

Economic status prerequisites

Students' economic status is defined on the basis of the Equivalent Economic Status Indicator (ISEE) for university funding, established by Prime Ministerial Decree no. 159 of 5 December 2013 as amended¹.

Students applying for right-to-study benefits must possess, with reference to their household:

¹ For the calculation of the ISEE Economic Status Indicator for entitlement to university funding, the criteria contained in Prime Ministerial Decree 159/2013 will be applied, with particular reference to art. 8 and the relative INPS circular no. 171 of 18/12/2014. Only in the cases specifically envisaged by article 9 of Prime Ministerial Decree 159/2013 as amended, a current, valid ISEE Certificate may be submitted.



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- of an Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE for subsidized benefits for the right to university study issued in 2026) **not exceeding €26,887.93**;
- a University Equivalent Capital Asset Indicator (ISP/equivalence scale) value **not exceeding €58,452.06**.



Both limits must be complied with; if either limit is exceeded, the student concerned will be considered not to meet the financial criteria and to be ineligible for funding.

Family unit

The student's family unit is defined in accordance with and using the methods specified in Prime Ministerial Decree no. 159 of 5 December 2013 and s.m.i..

Financially independent students

Students are considered financially independent when both the following circumstances apply:

- they have lived separately from their family unit of origin for at least two years prior to the date of submission of the personal declaration referring to the family unit, in accommodation not belonging to a member of the said family unit;
- they have filed tax returns declaring income from regular employment or contract work, of not less than € 9,000.00, for at least two years and not employed by a family member within the third degree of kinship.

If both the above circumstances do not apply and are not sufficiently documented, student shall not be considered financially independent; therefore, the income and asset status of his family unit of origin shall be considered for the purposes of the award process, and the student will have to submit, by the stated deadline, a new ISEE certification for entitlement to financial assistance for university study, from which it results that the student is included her/his family unit of origin, under penalty of exclusion from the rankings.

An independent student is classified as living away from home only if they reside in a verifiable paid accommodation within the Municipality where their attended course is located.

Income and asset assessment for foreign students

The economic status of foreign students or Italian students resident abroad is assessed in accordance with the provisions of article 8 comma 5 of Prime Ministerial Decree 159/2013.

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Students intending to submit applications for financial assistance must have their equivalent university funding **ISEEU parificato issued in 2026**, calculated by an affiliated tax advisory centre. Guidance and contacts are available on the website <https://www.unisr.it/en>, at the page “Student financial assistance schemes”.

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The income and asset status of foreign students from outside the European Union is assessed using the methods established by Legislative Decree no. 286 of 25 July 1998, as amended and by Presidential Decree no. 394 of 31 August 1999 as amended.

The income and asset status of the family units of foreign students must be certified by suitable documentation issued by the competent authorities of the countries in which the incomes are produced, and must be translated into Italian by the Italian diplomatic authorities with competence for the territory concerned.

In case of countries where there are particular difficulties in issuing the certification authenticated by the local Italian Embassy, it must be issued by the competent foreign representations or consuls in Italy and legalised by the Prefectures in accordance with art. 33 of Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28 December 2000.

For foreign students from particularly poor Countries², economic status is assessed on the basis of certification by the Italian Representation in the country of origin, confirming that the student does not belong to a wealthy family of high social status. The said certification may also be issued by the foreign university where the student is enrolled, linked to the University by agreements or conventions, or by Italian authorities empowered to issue guarantees of economic cover, in accordance with current regulations governing the matriculation of foreign students at Italian universities. In this last case, the certifying organisation undertakes to repay the scholarship on the student's behalf if it is revoked.

However, students are obliged in all cases to declare any incomes and assets held by their family unit in Italy in accordance with Prime Ministerial Decree 159/2013, with an ISEE certificate for university funding entitlement.

To allow evaluation of the income/assets of their family unit, all foreign students and Italian students resident abroad must submit the following documentation:

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- document certifying the composition of the family unit;
- income generated by every member of the family unit during the 2024 calendar year;
- documentation on the real estate owned by each member of the family unit, specifying the floor area of the properties owned as at 31 December 2024;
- proof of the movable assets by each member of the family unit during 2024.

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In all cases, the income declared by foreign students must be at least € 6,947.33 equivalent to the minimum living income, which must be proven when applying for a study visa for entrance to Italy. This value is the minimum threshold for the evaluation of economic status prerequisites.

ARTICLE 4. SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNTS

Scholarship amounts vary depending on both the different geographical provenance student's and the income band matching the **university I.S.E.E.** of the family unit, specified in the table below:

Geographical provenance

- **locally resident students:** resident in the Municipality where the course of study attended is located or residing in the surrounding areas, pursuant to Article 4, paragraph 8 of the Prime Minister's Decree of April 9, 2001, and who take, by public transportation, up to 60 minutes for the daily transfer to the course location;

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- **commuting students:** resident in a Municipality from which it is possible to reach the course location, by public transportation, with travel time between 60 and 90 minutes;
- **students living away from home:** resident in a Municipality from which travel to the course location is held takes more than 90 minutes by public transportation and therefore using rented accommodation near to the course location, living in public residential facilities or other housing provided by private or institutional landlords for at least 10 months of the 2026/2027 academic year. "Rented" accommodation supposes the existence of a formally registered lease in the name of the student or a parent or, for students living in public or private residential facilities, the existence of certification or other fiscally valid documentation proving payment of rent for the accommodation used. The lease or fiscal certification must be submitted by 27 November 2026 latest, before publication of the definitive ranking of students applying for a scholarship for the first time. For subsequent years, this status may be certified via a personal declaration if there have been no changes since the previous certification.

If this documentation is not provided, students will be classified as "commuting".

The amount of scholarships, including the regional university tax rebate, is as follows:

locally resident students:

1st income band: € 2,601.00 + one free meal a day giving a total of € 3,430.00

2nd income band: € 2,162.00 + one free meal a day giving a total of € 2,991.00

3rd income band: € 1,314.00 + one free meal a day giving a total of € 2,143.00

commuting students:

1st income band: € 3,991.00 + one free meal a day giving a total of € 4,820.00

2nd income band: € 3,362.00 + one free meal a day giving a total of € 4,191.00

3rd income band: € 2,470.00 + one free meal a day giving a total of € 3,299.00

students living away from home in Vita-Salute San Raffaele University accommodation:

1st income band: € 4,572.00 + accommodation and one free meal a day giving a total of € 8,248.00

2nd income band: € 3,496.00 + accommodation and one free meal a day giving a total of € 7,172.00

3rd income band: € 2,181.00 + accommodation and one free meal a day giving a total of € 5,857.00

students living away from home in other public or private accommodation:

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1st income band: € 7,419.00 + one free meal a day giving a total value of € 8,248.00

2nd income band: € 6,343.00 + one free meal a day giving a total value of € 7,172.00

3rd income band: € 5,028.00 + one free meal a day giving a total value of € 5,857.00

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All the above amounts, and the relative free services, will be halved for students who receive a scholarship for the year after the final year of the normal course of study, calculated from the year of matriculation.

Scholarships' beneficiary students and eligible students who are not beneficiary, enrolled in a subsequent year than the first, who are entitled to the free meal, will receive the cash amount equivalent to the meal service, equal to € 829.00.

Supplementation of scholarships in accordance with Ministerial Decree no. 1320 of 17 December 2021

a) Female students enrolled on Degree Courses in S.T.E.M. subjects (Sciences, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics)

For female students enrolled on the Bachelor's Degree Course in Biotechnology Research in Medicine, in the Master's Degree Course in Biotechnology for Innovative Therapeutics and in the Master's Degree Course in Health Informatics, the amount of the scholarship is increased by 20%. This increase cannot be combined with the 15% increase to be paid to students who have ISEE level below 50% of the relevant maximum limit, which is already included in the 1st income band scholarship amount. Therefore, for female students in both the 1st and the 2nd income bands, the increase is calculated on the basis of the value of the scholarship assigned in the 2nd band, while for those in the 3rd income band the value of the scholarship for this last band is used.

b) Students enrolled in two Course of Study simultaneously

Students who are simultaneously enrolled in two courses of study are permitted to obtain and retain their Scholarship, increased by 20%, provided they meet and continue to comply with the merit requirements throughout the entire duration of the Courses. This supplement is not due if students no longer meet the requirements for the scholarship with reference to the Course of Study to which they themselves associated it.

c) Students who graduate within the legal duration of the course

Students who obtain a Bachelor's degree, Master's degree, or Single-Cycle Master's degree within the timeframe established by their respective academic programs may, subject to the availability of funds,

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receive a scholarship supplement equal to half of the amount awarded for the academic year 2026/2027 during their final year of study, net of deductions for housing and dining services.

The assignment to beneficiary students of the aforementioned supplements to the scholarship is arranged **within the limits of financial availability** following the scrolling of the merit rankings of eligible students, according to the following order of priority:

- a) supplement relating to STEM students (art. 3 paragraph 5 of Ministerial Decree 1320/2021);
- b) supplement relating to students enrolled in more than one degree programme at the same time (art. 6 paragraph 3 of Ministerial Decree 1320/2021);
- c) supplement relating to "degree awards" (art. 2 paragraph 3 of Ministerial Decree 1320/2021).

ARTICLE 5. SUPPLEMENTATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS

a) Disabled students

For students with a certified disability of at least 66% or above or registered as disabled under art. 3, comma 1 of law no. 104 of 5 February 1992, the annual amount of the scholarship may be increased up to a maximum of 40% of the amount due. This scholarship increase may be granted upon the student's motivated and documented request, based on their condition of disability, in order to enable them to use prostheses and aids, as well as any measures which facilitate their access to teaching activities and study.

The amount of supplements shall be decided by a specific Commission.

b) International mobility

Students receiving scholarships for the 2026/2027 A.Y. and those who are eligible but not in receipt of scholarships (including PhD students) may apply for the allocation of supplementation of international mobility.

The scholarship supplement will be awarded on the basis of the academic merit ranking drawn up in accordance with article 6 below.

The grant is **€ 600.00 a month** for the duration of the time spent abroad, up to a maximum of ten months. The foreign study programme must be certified by the international exchange office of Vita-Salute San Raffaele University. The amount of any other grants received from European Union funds, from bilateral agreements (including non-EU) or from funds made available by public or private organisations will be deducted from the scholarship supplement paid by the University.

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Students are also entitled to a refund of return travel expenses for an amount up to **€ 100.00** for European countries and **€ 500.00** for non-European countries.

Grants for participation in international mobility programs are awarded to eligible students only once for each course attended.

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Students who, in accordance with Article 6 of the Agreement for International Mobility and Internships under the Erasmus Plus Program, fail to meet the terms or terminate it before its expiration for reasons other than those indicated in Article 13 thereof (termination in cases of circumstances that make the execution of the contract impracticable, impossible or excessively difficult) will have to return the amount of the international mobility supplement and the fee for travel expenses already disbursed.

ARTICLE 6. STUDENT RANKING FORMATION PROCEDURES

Student rankings are based on the following criteria:

a) For students enrolled in the first year of all Degree courses

The ranking for students enrolled for the first time in the first year of all courses is prepared on the basis of the family unit's Economic Status Indicator for university funding entitlement ("University I.S.E.E."), in relation to the maximum limit of €26,887.93, with a maximum of 1.000 points awarded using the following formula:

$$\left\{ 1 - \frac{\text{University I.S.E.E.}}{\text{€ 26,887.93}} \right\} \times 1000$$

Students are listed in the ranking in decreasing order of score awarded. If scores are tied, prevails the mark obtained in the educational qualification; if there is still a tie, the preference goes to the student younger in age.

Students who have not yet formally registered for the first year of a Master's Degree course in accordance with the University regulations will be entered in the ranking "under reservation" pending completion of registration.

b) Students enrolled in a subsequent year than the first of all Degree courses

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Students are listed in the ranking in decreasing order of total score derived from the sum of the number of ECTS-credits achieved **by 10 August 2026** (including the credits for the final examinations of internships undertaken and positive pass of professional activities carried out, for reasons relating to the university's own organisational planning, after 10 August 2026, provided the results of the said examinations are registered by 31 October 2026) and the score obtained from the average mark in the examinations taken. A total of 1.000 points are allocated, with 600 based on the number of ECTS credits earned and 400 based on the average grade in completed exams.

In case of a tie on academic merit, the student who has not used the ECTS-credit bonus will take precedence, followed by the student with the higher ranking on economic status. In case of a further tie, the younger student will prevail.

Method for calculation of academic merit score

The score for the ECTS gained by 10 August 2026 is calculated using the following formula:

$$(\text{Student's ECTS} - \text{Minimum ECTS}) \times \frac{600}{(\text{Maximum ECTS} - \text{Minimum ECTS})}$$

The score for the average mark in the examinations passed is calculated using the following formula:

$$(\text{Student's average mark} - \text{Pass mark}) \times \frac{400}{(\text{Maximum mark} - \text{Pass mark})}$$

c) Students enrolled in PhD and Specialisation courses

The ranking is drawn up on the basis of the criteria set out in point a) above.

If included in one of the eligibility rankings defined in points a), b) and c) above, students with certified disability of at least 66% or certified as disabled in accordance with art. 3, comma 1 of law no. 104 of 5 February 1992, are entitled to award of a scholarship even if this will be in addition to the number of scholarships initially offered.

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ARTICLE 7. TERMS AND PROCEDURES FOR SUBMITTING A SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Applications must be submitted **exclusively online by 12:00 at noon CEST on September 30, 2026**, via the website www.unisr.it, following the digital procedure available in the “Scholarships and Other Regional Benefits” section.

UniSR students must access the platform using their UniSR credentials (LOGIN ATENEO). If you are not yet enrolled at UniSR, you must register your personal information upon first access.

Once the application has been completed and finalized (by clicking “CONFIRM”) on the online platform, the following documents must be uploaded in PDF format in the “upload documents” section:

- ISEE certificate for university education benefits (**issued in the calendar year 2026** pursuant to D.P.C.M. 159/2013);
- Signed Single Substitute Declaration (D.S.U.) by the declarant;
- Alternatively, for foreign students and Italian students residing abroad:
 - **Equivalent ISEEU parificato issued in 2026;**
 - Copy of the documentation required under Article 3 of this call for applications, in the section titled “Assessment of Economic and Financial Status for Foreign Students”.

Additionally, for students with disabilities:

- Final report certifying disability status pursuant to Article 3, paragraph 1, Law 104/1992, or final report recognizing a disability equal to or greater than 66%, with diagnosis omitted;

Additionally, for independent students:

- Documentation proving the requirements outlined in Article 3 of this call for applications, in the section titled “Independent Student”.

Failure to submit a required document by the deadline or submission of an invalid document will result in exclusion from this selection process.

All declarations made in the application are considered issued pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 445 of December 28, 2000, and subsequent amendments and additions, and may only be submitted by candidates eligible to use the simplified administrative certification procedures permitted by the aforementioned decree.

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Foreign nationals residing in Italy may use substitute declarations and self-certifications under Legislative Decree 445/2000, but only in cases where they are certifying facts, conditions, or personal qualities that can be verified by Italian public or private entities, in accordance with the rules on self-certification.

Note: The deadlines for submitting the application and related documents for those applying for both a scholarship and subsidized housing are specified in Article 15.

Students participating in an international mobility program during the 2026/2027 academic year must request the scholarship supplement at the same time as submitting their scholarship application.

Students must promptly notify the Student Financial Aid Office in writing of any relevant events that occur after submitting the application, which may affect the allocation of benefits (e.g., receiving another scholarship or financial aid, transferring to another university, withdrawing from studies, changes in marital or financial status, etc.).

ARTICLE 8. PUBLICATION OF RANKINGS AND EVENTUAL FILING OF APPEALS

The students concerned are informed of the provisional rankings by **30 October 2026**.

Vita-Salute San Raffaele University will inform candidates of the outcome of the funding award procedure by publishing the ranking on the institutional website (www.unisr.it).

Any appeals to change ranking positions must be submitted to Vita-Salute San Raffaele University in writing no later than 15 days after publication of the rankings. Appeals must relate to errors in assessment on the part of the competent department and must be supported by documentation justifying the appeal.

Once the procedure relating to any appeals submitted has been completed, the definitive ranking will be published.

Any appeals against the definitive ranking must be submitted to the competent authorities within the terms envisaged by current law.

ARTICLE 9. AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND PAYMENT PROCEDURES – REVOCATION

Scholarships will be awarded until the number set by this call for applications has been completed.

If there are insufficient eligible students in some rankings, the residual scholarships will be awarded to students eligible in other rankings, until the total number of scholarships set by the call for applications itself has been awarded.

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Scholarships will be paid in instalments, at the due dates stated below, dependent on the prompt receipt of the relative funds from the Lombardy Region and the Ministry of Universities and Research.

Scholarships will only be paid by bank transfer to the current account specified in the scholarship application. This must be an Italian account held or at least jointly held in the beneficiary's student's name.

a) For students enrolled in the first year of all courses

Beneficiary scholarship students enrolled in the first year of all courses will receive the first instalment (equal to the half of the cash amount of the scholarship and equal to 50% of the standard meal allowance) by **31 December 2026**, with the balance payable by **30 September 2027**, provided the student has achieved, by **10 August 2027**:

- at least 49 ECTS-credits for students enrolled in Bachelor's and Single-Cycle Master's Degree courses;
- at least 45 ECTS-credits for students enrolled in Master's Degree courses.

The numbers of credits set out above do not include those relating to examinations already recognized at the time of enrolment, examinations taken in order to recoup educational deficits, surplus credits (in excess of the standard number or not included in the course curriculum), such as those credits which are not valid for the award of the degree, those not considered in the academic merit score and not valid for the purposes of the merit rankings. They do instead include the credits relating to the final examinations of internships undertaken and positive pass of professional activities carried out, for reasons relating to the university's own organisational planning, after 10 August 2027, provided the results of the said examinations are registered by 31 October 2027.

If they fail to achieve the minimum ECTS-credits required for payment of the balance of the scholarship, as specified above, by 10 August 2027, all **students in receipt of scholarships and eligible students not receiving scholarships** are entitled to total exemption of their enrolment fee and an exemption equal to the half of the tuition fees.

Students in the first year of all university courses, except for PhD and Specialisation courses, who have not achieved at least 35 ECTS-credits by 30 November 2027, will have their scholarships revoked. The above ECTS-credits must be achieved for the course in which students were enrolled in the year when the scholarship was awarded, or the course in which they enrol the following year, even if different.

A "bonus" of 5 ECTS-credits may be used in order to meet the above deadlines.

Students whose scholarship is revoked must repay the sums received and the amount corresponding to the value of the services actually used. They will also lose their right to exemption from university enrolment

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and tuition fees (**this applies both to students receiving scholarships and eligible students who do not receive them**) and students will have to regularize their administrative position. For this purpose, agreements may be reached for the payment of these sums in instalments.

Students with disabilities, as defined above, are not subject to the provisions regarding revocation of the scholarship and payment of the second instalment.

b) For students enrolled in a subsequent year than the first of all courses

Scholarships will be paid in two instalments, each amounting to half of the amount of the scholarship payable in cash and half of the amount established for meals, by the following due dates:

- **31 December 2026**
- **30 June 2027**

c) For students enrolled in PhD and Specialisation courses

Scholarships will be paid in two instalments, each amounting to half of the amount of the scholarship payable in cash and half of the amount established for meals, by the following due dates:

- **31 December 2026, or after the completion of the enrolment to the academic year, if it occurs in a subsequent date**
- **30 June 2027**

d) Supplementing the international mobility grant and reimbursement of travel expenses

These additional amounts will be granted to students included in the scholarship academic merit rankings until all funds available under this call for applications have been allocated. The amount due will be paid at the end of the period of study abroad, after verification with the University's international exchange offices that the obligations arising from participation in the exchange scheme have been fulfilled.

ARTICLE 10. INELIGIBILITY – FORFEITURE

Scholarships are not cumulative with other forms of funding provided by Vita-Salute San Raffaele University or by other public or private institutions, with the scholarships for foreign students awarded by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, or with the award of free accommodation in halls of residence or hostels; in these cases, students may decide which of the two forms of funding to accept. The above-mentioned does not apply to scholarships awarded by national or foreign institutions to enable scholarship students to undertake study abroad as part of their course of study or research.

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Students forfeit their right to the scholarship if:

- they incur in disciplinary measures higher than a caution, for offences committed against Vita-Salute San Raffaele University;
- they fail to submit any original documentation requested for verification of the accuracy of the self-certification submitted to Vita-Salute San Raffaele University by the requested deadline;
- Vita-Salute San Raffaele University verify that the data that students have declared in their self-certification are untrue;
- they submit an application to withdraw from their course or they transfer to another University during the 2026/2027 A.Y.

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ARTICLE 11. TRANSFERS

If a student transfers to another University after the beginning of the academic year, Vita-Salute San Raffaele University, on request, will transmit the application submitted to it to the Student Funding Department of the University to which the student has applied to transfer, and therefore the student will forfeit the scholarship granted by Vita-Salute San Raffaele University (and must therefore return any instalments already received).

Students who have transferred from another University to Vita-Salute San Raffaele University after the beginning of the academic year must ask the Student Funding Department of their University of origin to transmit their application, provided it has been submitted in compliance with the terms of the call for applications. The regularization of the transfer must be finalised by 25 November 2026, before the definitive student ranking is published.

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SECOND SECTION

ACCOMMODATION SERVICE AT REDUCED FEE AT

CASSINELLA HALL OF RESIDENCE

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ARTICLE 12. NUMBER OF ACCOMODATION PLACES

Number of accommodation places at the Cassinella Hall of Residence – located in Vimodrone, Street Cassinella – offered in the competition call for students enrolled with Vita-Salute San Raffaele University for the 2026/2027 academic year:

- a) **n. 4** for students enrolled in the first year of all Degree courses – from 25/09/2026 to 31/07/2027;
- b) **n. 29** for students enrolled in a subsequent year than the first of all Degree courses who have already been allocated a place in the Hall of Residence for the 2025/2026 academic year – from 11/09/2026 to 31/07/2027;
- c) **n. 1** for students enrolled in a subsequent year than the first of all Degree courses – from 25/09/2026 to 31/07/2027;
- d) **n. 1** for students enrolled in PhD courses (if not in receipt of a scholarship or a research grant), and in Specialisation courses (except for medical specialisation courses covered by Legislative Decree 368/99) – from 25/09/2026 to 31/07/2027.

If there are insufficient students eligible for accommodation places in some rankings, the residual places will be awarded to students eligible in other rankings, until the total number of accommodation places set by the call for applications itself has been awarded.

ARTICLE 13. PREREQUISITES FOR ENTERING THE COMPETITION AND REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING THE ACCOMMODATION RANKINGS

The competition call for the allocation of an accommodation place is open to students living away from home (see article 4) who have submitted a scholarship application and who thus meet the economic and academic merit requirements set out in the first part of this call for applications and that comply the conditions.

Students who have:

- been subject to University disciplinary measures more severe than a warning;

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- outstanding debts with Vita-Salute San Raffaele University;
- forfeited their room due to violation of the Hall of Residence regulations

will be excluded from the rankings for the allocation of accommodation places.

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ARTICLE 14. STUDENT RANKING FORMATION PROCEDURES

Student rankings are based on the following criteria:

a) Accommodation service at reduced fee for students enrolled in the first year of all Degree courses

The ranking for students enrolled for the first time in the first year of all courses is prepared on the basis of the family unit's Economic Status Indicator for university funding entitlement ("University I.S.E.E."), in relation to the maximum limit of €26,887,93, with a maximum of 1.000 points awarded using the following formula:

$$\left\{ 1 - \frac{\text{University I.S.E.E.}}{\text{€ 26,887.93}} \right\} \times 1000$$

Students are listed in the ranking in decreasing order of score awarded. If scores are tied, prevails the mark obtained in the educational qualification; if there is still a tie, the preference goes to the student younger in age.

b) Accommodation service at reduced fee for students enrolled in a subsequent year than the first of all Degree courses who have already been allocated a place in the Hall of Residence for the 2025/2026 academic year

The order in the ranking is determined, in decreasing way, by total score derived from the sum of the number of ECTS-credits achieved **by 10 August 2026** and the score obtained from the average mark in the examinations taken. A total of 1.000 points are available, broken down as follows: 600 on the basis of the number of ECTS-credits gained and 400 on the basis of the average mark of the examinations passed.

When calculating the number of ECTS-credits, internships undertaken and positive pass of professional activities carried out, for reasons relating to the university's own organisational planning, after 10 August 2026, will also be considered on a "provisional" basis, provided the corresponding ECTS-credits are registered by 31 October 2026. If the failure to gain the ECTS-credits by the above deadline means that the

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student in question fails to reach the minimum total ECTS-credits required by this call for applications, he or she will be excluded from definitive ranking.

In case of a tie about the academic merit, the student who has not used the ECTS-credit bonus will take precedence, followed by the student with the higher ranking on economic status. In case of a further tie, the younger student will prevail.

Method for calculation of academic merit score

The score for the ECTS gained by 10 August 2026 is calculated using the following formula:

$$(\text{Student's ECTS} - \text{Minimum ECTS}) \times \frac{600}{(\text{Maximum ECTS} - \text{Minimum ECTS})}$$

The score for the average mark in the examinations passed is calculated using the following formula:

$$(\text{Student's average mark} - \text{Pass mark}) \times \frac{400}{(\text{Maximum mark} - \text{Pass mark})}$$

c) Accommodation service at reduced fee for students enrolled in a subsequent year than the first of all Degree courses

The ranking is drawn up on the basis of the criteria set out in point b) above.

d) Accommodation service at reduced fee for students enrolled in PhD and Specialisation courses

The ranking is drawn up on the basis of the criteria set out in point a) above.

Students who have not yet formalized the enrolment, in accordance with the University regulations, will enter the rankings "under reservation" pending completion of registration.

In all rankings, priority will be given to students with a record of verification of disability status pursuant to Article 3, Paragraph 1, of Law No. 104 of February 5, 1992, or a final record of disability equal to or greater than 66%, until all eligible accommodations for applicants are exhausted.

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ARTICLE 15. DEADLINES AND PROCEDURES FOR SUBMISSION OF AN ACCOMMODATION APPLICATION

The accommodation application for the competition call has to be presented using the form annexed to this call for applications and must be submitted by the following deadlines:

- by 12:00 at noon CEST on **18 August 2026** for students already allocated in accommodation at the Hall of Residence in the 2025/2026 A.Y., covered by point b) of article 12;
- by 12:00 at noon CEST on **8 September 2026** for new assignee students, covered by points a), c) and d) of article 12.

Applications must be submitted **exclusively online**, via the website www.unisr.it, following the digital procedure available in the “Scholarships and Other Regional Benefits” section.

UniSR students must access the platform using their UniSR credentials (LOGIN ATENEO). If you are not yet enrolled at UniSR, you must register your personal information upon first access.

Once the application has been completed and finalized (by clicking “CONFIRM”) on the online platform, the following documents must be uploaded in PDF format in the “upload documents” section:

- for allocations reserved to new assignee students, covered by points a), c) and d) of article 12: by **23 September 2026**.

Vita-Salute San Raffaele University will inform candidates of the outcome of the funding award procedure by publishing the ranking on the institutional website (www.unisr.it).

Any appeals to change ranking positions must be submitted to Vita-Salute San Raffaele University in writing no later than 15 days after publication of the rankings. Appeals must relate to errors in assessment on the part of the competent department and must be supported by documentation justifying the appeal.

Once the procedure relating to any appeals submitted has been completed, the definitive ranking will be published.

Any appeals against the definitive ranking must be submitted to the competent authorities within the terms envisaged by current law.

ARTICLE 17. CONFIRMATION AND ALLOCATION OF ACCOMODATION PLACES

Following the publication of the rankings, students who have been allocated accommodation will be notified by e-mail by residenza.universitaria@unisr.it. **Within 5 days** of receiving this notification, students **must confirm** their accommodation place exclusively in accordance with the communicated procedures.

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If the eligible student does not confirm within 5 days of receipt of the communication, he/she will be considered to have withdrawn and will lose the right to be allocated accommodation.

Rooms will be allocated from:

- **11 September 2026** for students who have already been assigned a place in the Hall of Residence for the 2025/2026 academic year, covered by point b) of article 12;
- **25 September 2026** for new assignee students who do not already have places, covered by points a), c) and d) of article 12.

The assignment of the accommodation takes place upon delivery of the receipt of the deposit payment, a copy of a valid identity document and the signing of;

- letter of acceptance of the accommodation and of the acknowledgment of the Regulations;
- information note on the protection of personal data.

Rooms are allocated ex officio by the Hall of Residence Administration on the basis of the ranking order and is valid for the entire period.

The Hall of Residence remains closed for the Christmas holiday from **24 December 2026 until 6 January 2027**.

Cohabitation in the accommodation facilities is governed by the Residence Regulations, available on the "Student Residences" page of the institutional website (www.unisr.it).

Signing the letter of acceptance is considered as acceptance of all the rules contained in the Regulations of the University Residences.

ARTICLE 18. FEES AND PAYMENT PROCEDURES

Fees refer to the use of the room for the period:

- from 11 September 2026 to 23 December 2026 and from 7 January 2027 to 31 July 2027 for students who have already been assigned a place in the Hall of Residence for the 2025/2026 academic year, covered by point b) of article 12;
- from 25 September 2026 to 23 December 2026 and from 7 January 2027 to 31 July 2027 for new assignee students, covered by points a), c) and d) of article 12.

The reduced fee for the entire period, amounting to **€ 2,847.00**, comprises:

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- weekly cleaning and fresh linen service;
- use of all communal services in the Hall, in accordance with the rules.

Fees must be paid by the procedures detailed on the website www.unisr.it/en, at the page “UniSR residences” at the due dates set out below:

- Eligible students not in receipt of a scholarship:
 - Euro 949.00 by 31/12/2026;
 - Euro 949.00 by 10/01/2027;
 - Euro 949.00 by 30/04/2027.
- Beneficiary students’ scholarships: the amounts will be deducted from the scholarship itself.

Fees must be fully paid also by the students who leave the Residences for a period with a valid reason or due to force majeure for which the University is not responsible.

ARTICLE 19. DEPOSIT

Before occupying the room, each student must provide a € 500.00 deposit non-interest bearing, to be paid at the time of signing the letter of acceptance of the room.

For students who have already been allocated an accommodation, after signing the acceptance form for the 2026/2027 academic year, the amount of € 500.00 that they already paid as deposit in the previous academic year, is considered valid.

The deposit will be returned by bank transfer, without interest, to students who make a formal request to this effect at the end of their stay, within 90 days from the inspection of the general condition of the room and its fittings and furniture, performed by a member of the administrative staff in the presence of the Resident student.

The deposit can also be used as a source of compensation for any damage to the structure of the Hall of Residence and furthermore, deductions can be made to offset any outstanding amounts owed to the University.

ARTICLE 20. FORFEITURE OF ACCOMMODATION

Students shall forfeit their room if, during their period of residence, they:

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- fail to complete the enrolment at the course for the 2026/2027 academic year;
- submit an application to withdraw from their course or transfer to another University during the 2026/2027 A.Y.;
- graduate;
- incur in disciplinary measures, imposed by University, more severe than a warning;
- fail to submit any original documentation requested for verification of the accuracy of the self-certification submitted to Vita-Salute San Raffaele University by the requested deadline;
- fail to comply with the University Hall of Residence Regulations;
- fail to comply with any measures enforced by Vita-Salute San Raffaele University to contain emergencies, including those introduced to deal with pandemic or emergency situations which may affect the health and safety of other students and the population at large.



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THIRD PART

GENERAL INFORMATION AND FINAL PROVISIONS

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ARTICLE 21. VERIFICATION OF ECONOMIC STATUS

For verification of economic status, Vita-Salute San Raffaele University will exercise the options available to it under current law, specifically art. 10 of Legislative Decree no 68 of 29 March 2012, art. 71 of Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28 December 2000, art. 38 of Decree Law no. 78 dated 31 May 2010 (converted, with amendment, into law no. 122 of 30 July 2010), and art. 11 of Prime Ministerial Decree no. 159 of 5 December 2013 and the relative INPS Pension Authority Circular no. 171 of 18 December 2014, also demanding all relevant documentation for verification of the accuracy of the statements issued (personal and corporate tax returns, VAT returns, etc.). For verification purposes, the University may also rely on the collaboration of the Guardia di Finanza, within the framework of the Memorandum of Understanding signed on November 29, 2024.

In the event of false declarations, scholarships awarded will be revoked and the students concerned will receive the penalties envisaged by articles 75 and 76 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, art. 10 of Legislative Decree 68/2012 and art. 38 of Decree Law n. 78/2010, converted with amendments by law no. 122/2010.

In no case shall the above preclude the adoption of disciplinary measures or reporting to the judicial authorities if a crime is considered to have been committed.

ARTICLE 22. DATA PROTECTION

Vita-Salute San Raffaele University, with registered office in Milan, Via Olgettina 58, tax code 97187560152 (hereinafter the **"University"**) undertakes to constantly protect the personal data of data subjects, in accordance with the provisions of Reg. (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter the **"Regulation"** or **"GDPR"**) and of Italian Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 (hereinafter the **"Data Protection Code"**).

DATA CONTROLLER AND DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

The Data Controller is Vita-Salute San Raffaele University.

In accordance with the provisions **(i)** of the Regulation (see article 37) and **(ii)** of the CODAU University Administration Association Guidelines, the University has designated GSD SISTEMI E SERVIZI S.C.A.R.L. as its Data Protection Officer (hereinafter **"DPO"**).

CATEGORIES AND TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED AND PURPOSES OF THE PROCESSING

The personal data you provide—such as identification details, contact information, academic background, financial data, and health-related information (hereinafter collectively referred to as 'Personal Data')—are processed for purposes relating solely to the process of selection and allocation of benefits for the right to study for which you have applied.

Data will be processed in accordance with art. 6, para 1, point e) of the GDPR and, with regard to health data, in accordance with art. 9, para 2, point g). Except for your special categories of data, your personal data may be disseminated through the online publication of the student rankings. You will never be publicly identified by means of your name and/or surname; only your ID code (pre-registration number) will be used.

COMPULSORY NATURE OF THE CONTRIBUTION OF DATA AND STORAGE TIMES

The contribution of the Personal Data requested is compulsory and in case of failure to contribute them it will be impossible to proceed with the selection process.

The Personal Data acquired will be stored for a period of 1 year from the end of the selection, after which your data will be completely anonymised.

DATA PROCESSING PROCEDURES

Personal Data are processed using manual and automated tools, by methods strictly correlated to the relative purposes, by means of appropriate security measures and for the period of time required by the current regulatory framework.

DISCLOSURE OF DATA

Your Personal Data will not be disseminated. This will, however, not apply if the disclosure or dissemination of your Personal Data is required, in accordance with the law, by public authorities for the purposes of defence, security or the prevention, investigation or repression of crimes, or by public entities (government bodies, ministries, Inland Revenue, pension and welfare institutions, public health surveillance organisations and the police) in accordance with legal obligations. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

Data subjects are entitled to apply to the University, at any time, for access to their personal data, or for their rectification or erasure, or to object to their processing in the circumstances envisaged by art. 20 of the Regulation, and are entitled to request the restriction of processing in the circumstances covered by art. 18 of the Regulation, and to obtain the personal data concerning them in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format (portability) in the circumstances envisaged by art. 20 of the Regulation.

Requests must be sent in writing, by email to the Data Controller and the DPO.

Data subjects are entitled at all times to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority (Italian Personal Data Protection Authority), under art. 77 of the Regulation, if they believe that their data are being processed in breach of the current law.
