REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION BY STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES IN MEETINGS OF THE BODIES OF VITA-SALUTE SAN RAFFAELE UNIVERSITY



Art. 1 - Student participation

The students of Vita-Salute San Raffaele University may participate, through their representatives, in meetings of the Academic Senate, the University Board of Evaluation and the University Quality Department when the topics dealt with in such meetings concern matters of pre-eminent interest to them.

Student representatives are not included in the calculation of the majorities required for the validity of meetings and any resolutions adopted, but they are entitled to speak and to make proposals.

Student representatives, in the number and according to the procedures provided for in Article 2 of these regulations, are appointed by the Students' Council, the body representing students within the University.

The composition and functions of the Students' Council are governed by specific regulations adopted by the aforementioned body.

Art. 2 - Student representatives and appointment

The number of student representatives is set at:

- three representatives (one for each Faculty) to be appointed to the Academic Senate;
- one representative to be appointed to the University Board of Evaluation;
- one representative to be appointed to the University Quality Department.

The aforementioned student representatives are elected and appointed in the manner laid down in the Regulations of the Students' Council.

Art. 3 - Duration and termination of office

Representatives hold office for two years and their term of office ends when new representatives are appointed by the Students' Council.

In the event of resignation or loss of requirements by one of the representatives, or loss of the status of student of Vita-Salute San Raffaele University, a new appointment shall be made.

Art. 4 – Final provisions



These Regulations shall enter into force on the day following the day of issue of this Rector's Decree. For any aspect not provided for in these Regulations, the applicable legislation shall apply.
