Transfer procedure to the International MD Program

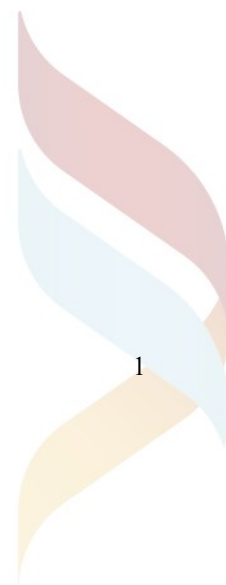

How to send in your request:

Students must send in the documentation listed below **within July 26 2019** to the email address transfers.IMDP@univr.it

The documents to attach to the email are:

- a) **Transfer Application form** indicating also which year you want to transfer to (please note that requests for transfers to year 5 or 6 are not allowed and the request will not be considered);
- b) Students coming from Italian Universities: *Autocertificazione esami svolti con CFU e voto*. Self-written declarations/scores and credits will not be accepted;
2. Students enrolled to Foreign Universities – Official transcripts with exams taken and scores obtained. All documentation must have the seal and signature of the University of origin. The grading system must be indicated as well and the documents must have a verified translation into English;
- c) **Complete syllabus of the entire medical school program**- with verified translation into English if not originally either in Italian or English;
- d) **Table A** filled out in all relevant parts;
- e) **Motivational letter** (400 words maximum);





- f) Payment receipt of **euro 100** to be paid with bank transfer to

- g) English language Knowledge Certification corresponding to **C1 level**;
- h) Copy of **identity document** / passport.

Any document which is not in English or Italian must be translated into one or the other language.

Evaluation of transfer requests:

Candidates whose preceding career can be comparable to the IMDP curriculum, which means they have already covered the topics and obtained credits for the exams as programmed in the IMDP curriculum year 1, 2 and/or 3 for a number of credits sufficient for being admitted to a higher year, will be admitted to the **NBME exam** (an exam which is given to the University directly by the National Board of Medical Examiners), which will assess the Student's preparation on the following courses:

For admission to year 2:

3h test

150 questions on the following:

1. Statistics and Bioinformatics
2. Cell & Molecular Biology
3. Human Genetics and Genomics
4. Chemistry & Biochemistry

For admission to year 3 also:

4h test

150 questions on the following:

5. Human Morphology
 6. Physiology
 7. Principles of Pharmacology
 8. Introduction to Surgery
- + other 50 questions on the subjects 1, 2, 3 and 4





For admission to year 4 also:

4h test

150 questions on the following:

9. Pathology
 10. Microbiology
 11. Laboratory Medicine
 12. Digestive System Diseases/Surgery
 13. Cardiovascular Diseases
 14. Respiratory & ENT Diseases
- + other 50 questions on the subjects 1, 2, 3, 4 and other 50 questions on subjects 5, 6, 7 and 8.

This exam will be held in **Università Vita-Salute San Raffaele** on a date to be decided and is obligatory for those who will be admitted to the test. Not sitting it means the Student's transfer request is automatically rejected.

It is a **computer based multiple choice questionnaire** which will last 3 hours for students requesting a transfer to year 2 plus other 4 hours for students requesting a transfer to year 3. *Further details on the exam will be given to the Transfer students once they are admitted to sit it.*

Only the following subjects will be evaluated based only on the curriculum comparison and scores obtained:

1. Humanities
2. Medical Physics
3. Basic life Support

Students will be admitted to the transfer year they requested if they obtain a result which is similar to the average of the class in which they wish to be transferred. These Students will be allowed to enroll according to the number of places available in the year they are transferring to.

The transfer of Students enrolled to foreign medical Schools will be ultimately confirmed by the positive resolution of the Ministry of Education, University and Research.
