Admission requirements	Master's Degree in Medicine and Surgery, with qualification to practice.
Preferred Qualifications	Best suited candidates hold a specialization in Digestive Diseases, Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine and Critical Care Medicine, General Surgery, Paediatrics, Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology.
Learning objectives	The II level Master's Degree in <i>Advanced Clinical Inflammatory Bowel Disease</i> aims to provide and expand medical and diagnostic knowledge for the management of patients suffering from chronic inflammatory bowel diseases. The Master will be mainly focused on the application of advanced therapies (biological and small molecules) in clinical practice. In addition, it will concentrate on patient management according to the standard of care recommended by the most recent guidelines of the European Crohn's and Colitis Organization (ECCO), as well as on new therapeutic targets (treat-to-target and tight control strategies).
Field of Employment	The Master is oriented to doctors, particularly those specialized in Gastroenterology and Digestive Endoscopy, Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine and Critical Care Medicine, General Surgery, Paediatrics, Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology.

Learning Activities' Structure	<u>Frontal teaching activities</u> will be delivered remotely, both asynchronously (theoretical lessons) and synchronously (end-of-module Q&A sessions). <u>Professional training</u> will take place in person according to the arrangements and schedule defined with the Master's Director and tutors. The award of the qualification is subject to the completion of a total of 60 ECTS credits, distributed as follows: • Frontal teaching activities: 32 ECTS



	• Professional training: 24 ECTS • Final thesis: 4 ECTS

Evaluation	The admission to the Master is based on an evaluation of the candidate's academic and professional titles. Each candidate could achieve a <u>maximum of 10 points</u> based on the following criteria: • Title of Specialization: maximum 3 points • (3 points for the specialization in Digestive Disease; 2 points for Internal Medicine, General Surgery, Paediatrics, Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology; 1 point for Emergency Medicine and Critical Care Medicine); • Other qualifications: maximum 1 point; • Academic and Professional Curriculum: maximum 3 points; • Scientific publications: maximum 3 points. An admission ranking will be listed.
