The ICC in TM is dedicated to those who wish to enhance their skills, know-how and expertise, while developing a significant network of professional and informal interactions.

The Educational objectives of the course are to:

- Analyse the business, scientific and regulatory aspects of TM
- Explore the challenges that professionals encounter in TM
- Develop critical thinking skills to approach the challenges in TM
- Develop communication skills for presenting complex scientific ideas to a broad spectrum of people

The four positions – each including all costs associated with the course, the exam and hosting aspects in Ortigia (Siracusa) – will be assigned to UniSR **Researchers / Associate Professors or to UniSR and IRCCS Ospedale San Raffaele post-doctoral fellows.**

Evaluation of applications and assignment of the 4 positions

The submitted applications will be evaluated by a committee composed of:

The Committee will assess the consistency between the candidates' research profiles and the topic of the Course.

In case of equal qualification of two or more candidates, the position will be awarded to the candidate who submitted their application first.
