## ADMISSION TO THE INTERNATIONAL MD PROGRAM A.Y 2019/2020

### CALL RESERVED TO EU CITIZENS

#### FOREWARD:

This call is reserved to European Citizens.

*This quota includes: EU Citizens, Non-European citizens already residing in Italy, Citizens from Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Switzerland and the Republic of San Marino (Ministerial Prot. N° 7802 of March 24, 2015)*

#### GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Admittance to the International MD Program is subject to selection through the University's admission test. N° 36 places are reserved for European Citizens in the A.Y 2019/2020 and the test will be **computer-based** and held on one of the following dates (according to the choice of the candidate and to the availability): **March 2, March 5 or March 9, 2019 in Milan only.**
2. Registration to the test is done online through the University website. Registration is considered complete once you have filled in all fields and paid the test fee corresponding to € 170.
3. Registration to the admission test **opens on December 3, 2018 and closes on February 20 at noon (CET).**
4. The minimum requirement for enrolling is the possession of a high school diploma with at least 12 years of education. Further details on specific foreign High school diplomas can be found at this link: <http://www.unisr.it/en/masters-degree-medicine-and-surgery/international-md-program/#requirements>. Foreign high school diplomas must have the declaration of Validity (Dichiarazione di Valore), which is issued by the Italian Consulates. It is the Student's responsibility to verify s/he has the requirements to obtain the necessary papers from the Consulate in time for enrolling. 5. An English language Certification is requested as well in order to finalize enrolment. Verify the details in point 7.
6. Notes marked with \*\*\* means the information is not present in the Italian competition call but is added for extra information useful to International Students.
7. Please note that all time indications in this call refer to the local time in Milan.

*The Regulation for Admittance to the A.Y 2019/2020 available in English, translates and lists the points of the Italian Competition Call **DR 5813** only for information purposes. It does not have legal value since the Italian version of is the only official document regulating the competition.*

## REGULATION FOR ADMISSION TO THE INTERNATIONAL MD PROGRAM EU CITIZENS

A.Y 2019/2020

### 1. NUMBER OF PLACES AVAILABLE

Selection for admission to the single-cycle degree course in Medicine and Surgery in English – the 'International MD Program' (Classification: LM-41) is disciplined by an examination and based on the number of places available which are to be confirmed by the resolution of the Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research – MIUR. **The number of places available for European Citizens for the A.Y. 2019/2020 is 36.**

### 2. PARTICIPATION TO THE COMPETITION AND DEFINING THE EUROPEAN QUOTA

*2.1 Who can participate to this competition?* EU Citizens, Non-European citizens residing in Italy and Citizens from Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Switzerland and the Republic of San Marino (Ministerial Prot. N° 7802 of March 24, 2015) can participate to this competition. Hereafter they will all be referred to as *European Citizens*.

*2.2 What are the academic requirements for enrolling to the MD Program?* A High School Certificate (law n°910 art.1 December 11). Students who possess a foreign (non-Italian) High School Certificate/Diploma, must verify they meet the requirements indicated by the Ministerial Prot. N° 7802 of February 28, 2017 ([http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/moduli/2017/Circolare2017\\_2018En.pdf](http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/moduli/2017/Circolare2017_2018En.pdf)) and following updates, in order to be eligible for enrolment.

The regulation for admittance to Italian Universities and requirements is defined by the Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research MIUR. European students who intend to enroll to the International MD Program, compete for the specific number of seats reserved to them which is n°36 places for the academic year 2019/2020. The International MD Program course is entirely taught in English therefore proof of Italian language knowledge is not requested. The availability of the programmed number of places is subject to the conditions of approval from the MIUR.

### 3. REGISTRATION TO THE ADMISSION TEST

3.1 Registration – In order to sit the admission test, candidates are requested to pay the test fee which amounts to euro 170.00 Payment is done according to the modalities indicated on the online registration form. Registration to the test is considered complete when the registration form has been filled in and the test fee paid. Payment alone of the test fee does not mean the candidate has registered correctly to the test. The fee will not be reimbursed should the candidate not sit the test no matter what reasons s/he has for not participating to the test.

Registration to the test is done exclusively online by following the links available on the University website <http://www.unisr.it>

Registration to the admission test **opens on December 3, 2018 and closes on February 20, 2019 at noon.**

1. Between **December 3, 2018 and February 20, 2019 at noon**, each candidate has to sign up, pay the test fee and book one of the slots available as detailed in point 3.2
2. Between **February 20, 2019 noon and February 23, 2019 at noon**, candidates who have already booked their session and paid the test fee before February 20, 2019, but need to make changes, will have the possibility of doing so if there are seats available in the other sessions.

### 3.2 How to register: 5 steps

1. The candidate enters his/her personal data
2. After having registered, s/he follows the link to the website where s/he will be able to see the active sessions still available and can pay for the chosen admission test.
3. The candidate receives an email confirming that the payment has been done correctly
4. Once the payment has been confirmed, the candidate is able to book his/her seat/test date with the only limit being the slots available on the chosen date.
5. The candidate receives a mail confirming his/her registration and booking of the exam session.

Each candidate will be able to choose the exam session among those available **only after having paid the test fee**. The system will prevent bookings if the session is already fully booked. In this case the candidate will have to select another session available. Changes of the test session can be carried out directly by the candidate by:

1. Entering the system with username and password
2. Verifying the seat availability in the new chosen session
3. Making a new reservation.

A change of the test day will be permitted only until February 23, 2019 at noon. This is a definite deadline. Any candidate who is not able to take part to the selected session and has not changed session before the deadline, will be not be allowed to sit the test on another date even if there are available seats.

A summary table will be published on the University website ([www.unisr.it](http://www.unisr.it)) after February 23, 2019 with the pre-enrolment code for each candidate and for each test session.

Please be aware that each candidate is responsible for the details s/he indicates on the registration form. In case of wrong, missing or untruthful data, the candidate will not be listed in the final ranking list and consequently will be prevented from enrolling. The University will randomly verify the information provided by the candidates.

### 4. DELIVERY OF THE ADMISSION TEST

#### 4.1 Registration and session selection

The admission test for the San Raffaele International MD Program reserved to the EU citizens' quota will be held **between March 2 and March 9, 2019 at the Selexi test Center, (Centro Direzionale Valtorta, Torre A, 1B floor - via G. Vida, 11, Milan). The test will be computer-based.**

Based on the number of candidates who registered for the last admission tests and to the availability of computer seats, the EU Citizens' admission test is organized in more than one session as follows:

Should technical problems prevent one or more candidates from taking or finishing the test, the University will schedule an extra session *only* for those candidates who have experienced such problems. If an anomaly occurs during the test, the exam software continuously registers and saves any input given by the candidate together with the time still available. Therefore, if a single computer accidentally stops working, the issue will be

immediately dealt with by the staff: the candidate will be able to resume the exam from his/her computer or from a different computer reserved to emergency cases, without this affecting the exam itself.

Should the total number of seats available be not sufficient for the number of candidates registered for the admission test, a new session can be scheduled. In this case, information and details will be available on the University website.

**Candidates are requested to present at the time indicated in the above table. The test will start when the candidate identification procedure has finished for all candidates.**

Candidates will be permitted to sit for the test upon handing a valid identity document at their arrival.

Candidates will be taking the test using a computer, equipped with only a mouse, which will be exclusively connected to the exam session software. Each candidate will be able to choose his/her own seat and will have to insert username and password s/he was given during the identification procedure. The admission test will start contemporarily for all candidates once the person in charge of the session will proceed with the test activation. Until that moment the software used for the exam will remain encrypted.

Each candidate can finish the admission test before the given time by clicking on "finish the test" or can stay in the hall until the time finishes. In both cases, the software tracks and saves every change done before the time runs out.

Thanks to the matching between the Candidate PIN code given to each student during the identification procedure, and the test code, which is created randomly only when the test begins, each candidate will be unequivocally and automatically connected to the test taken.

**Candidates who arrive late and after the official beginning of the test, will not be allowed to sit for the test no matter what reasons they have for their lateness.**

Special needs: Candidates with any kind of permanent or temporary disability in need of extra means of support, must formally request the support they will need for this test in relation to the extent of their disability, be it also further time for completing the test (*law n° 104 February 5, 1992 and as modified by the law n.17/1999*). Candidates with learning disabilities according to the law n°170 October 8, 2010 with the new regulation concerning *specific learning disabilities within the educational environment* can request the special terms foreseen from the Ministerial Decree n. 5669, July12, 2011.

**All these requests must be accompanied by a medical certificate and sent to the Head of the Selection Procedure via e-mail to [dsa.sd@unisr.it](mailto:dsa.sd@unisr.it) no later than the application deadline for registration foreseen by this competition call.** According to the law, certificates confirming learning disabilities must not be older than 3 years and must be issued by specialists or offices of the National Health System or by private health institutions recognized by the National Health System.

#### 4.2 CONTENT OF THE TEST

The test is entirely in English and consists of 100 multiple choice questions divided as follows:

- 60 logic, problem solving and Text Comprehension questions
- 40 questions on scientific subjects (Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics)

Candidates have 120 minutes to complete the test.

The questions of the admissions test are property of Università Vita-Salute San Raffaele, managed by a third party and randomly extracted from a database.

Since the admission test be delivered in more sessions and in order to guarantee transparency and impartiality, each exam session will have its own set of questions divided as previously explained.

For each exam session there will be three different sets of questions available. One of these three sets of questions will be randomly chosen through an automated tool before the beginning of each session.

#### 4.3 Reserve questions and deleting procedure

At the end of the test (i.e. at the end of the 120 minutes or if the candidate decides to finish the test earlier) every candidate will have to answer 6 more questions in a time which is proportional to the time given for the entire test and which is calculated automatically by the software. These reserve questions are coherent with those of the test and WILL NOT count as part of the test but will only be considered if, at the end of all scheduled sessions, an anomaly should emerge on one or more questions. Only in this case, the Head of the Selection Procedure, after having received the Committee's opinion, can decide to delete that particular question and substitute it with one of the extra questions on the same topic.

#### 4.4 Delivery of the test

At the test center, after identification, each candidate will have to confirm his/her presence by signing a register and will be given a pen and sheet for writing notes and calculations. Candidates will not be allowed any other equipment with exception for what is permitted to candidates with disabilities (point 4.1).

After the identification procedure has been completed, the candidates will be accompanied to the test hall and will be asked to occupy a computer seat. Each candidate will then be able to enter the system using the PIN code s/he was given during the identification procedure and will be allowed to access the following information on:

- How to answer the test questions
- How to confirm the chosen answer by using the mouse and selecting the corresponding box. *Answers written on the paper sheets given for making notes will not be considered.*
- How to modify or delete the given answers. This will be possible for the entire duration of the test.
- The possibility of making notes and calculations and how to ask for more paper if needed.
- How to leave the hall in case of particular needs and accompanied by a staff member.

During the test, candidates will not be allowed to talk or to write to anyone apart from the staff and supervising committee. Candidates will also not be allowed to keep personal belongings with them such as bags, books or notes, dictionaries, mobile phones, smart watches, calculators or any electronic device. Candidates will be given indications for storing these items in a specific place. Violation of this rule means being expelled from the competition. The Test Committee will ensure that rules are respected and will act accordingly if any violation occurs.

## 5 – THE RANKING LIST

After all exam sessions have ended, the tests will be anonymously corrected and scores assigned as follows:

- 1 point for each correct answer
- - 0,25 points for each incorrect answer
- 0 points for each non given answer.

The automatic correction of the tests and the elaboration of the ranking lists through the matching between the scores and the Candidate names, will be done only once all sessions have closed.

The ranking is formed with the overall score obtained by each candidate.

At the end of the score calculation through the university website [www.unisr.it](http://www.unisr.it) each candidate will have access to the Online Review where they can enter the system with the login details given at the test and view his/her test and the score obtained.

The Registrar will publish a notice on the website [www.unisr.it](http://www.unisr.it) concerning the opening of the Online Review system at the end of the admission test sessions.

The final ranking will be published within 7 days from the end of the last exam session or in any case, within the terms of law,

In case of a draw, the points scored by the candidate in Logic, Problem solving, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics will prevail in descending order. In case of a further draw, the place is assigned to the youngest candidate.

The scores obtained by the candidates and the ranking list will be available on line on the University website: <http://www.unisr.it/ateneo/albo-online/>

**Candidates ranking within the first 36 position will be admitted to enrolment. Candidates admitted to enrolment who have scored equal or higher than 40/100 will proceed with enrolment acknowledging they do not have missing educational requirements.**

**Candidates admitted to enrolment who have scored less than 40/100 will be requested to recover the missing educational requirements during the first year according to the indications they will receive from the Academic Board once enrolled.**

**Candidates who have scored less than 35/100 will not be admitted to enrolment even if the scrolling of the ranking lists should reach their position.**

## **6 –ADMISSION TO ENROLMENT**

Publication of the ranking lists on the university web-site is the **only official means of communication**. The Registrar's Office may send emails to the personal email address entered by the candidates during the registration process only for helping them out with the registration procedure. These communications, however, will never be considered as substitution for the official messages published on the university web-site. It is, therefore, the candidate's responsibility to verify his/her position in order to proceed with enrolment within the given deadlines by checking the webpage regularly.

Admitted candidates must follow the detailed instructions for enrolment, which will be published online on the University website by the Registrar's Office.

The online enrolment procedure will **open on July 1 2019** and will **close on July 23, 2019** according to the modalities indicated on the online enrolment procedure.

During this period, all the admitted candidates, apart from those who are already enrolled to a degree course of Vita-Salute San Raffaele University (see point 7.1), will have to:

- Follow the online enrolment procedure indications
- Print out the form at the end of the enrolment procedure (enrolment request form)
- Make the payment of the first instalment using the MAV form available at the end of the online enrolment procedure
- Send as pdf attachment (no other format will be accepted) the enrolment form filled out and signed, a copy of the payment confirmation, a copy of the English Knowledge certificate (please see point. 7), a

copy of a valid identity document to the email address [enrolment.imdprogram@univr.it](mailto:enrolment.imdprogram@univr.it) specifying as Re: Enrolment to the International MD Program”.

- Admitted Candidates with any kind of permanent or temporary disability must formally request the support they will need for their studies. Candidates with learning disabilities according to the law n°170 October 8, 2010 with the new regulation concerning *specific learning disabilities within the educational environment* can request the special terms envisaged by the Ministerial Decree n. 5669, July12, 2011.

In order to apply, candidates have to download the form available online and send it to [enrolment.imdprogram@univr.it](mailto:enrolment.imdprogram@univr.it) specifying 'Enrolment to the International MD Program' with all documents requested in the same format and all the enrolment papers.

**The Registrar's office will send an email to confirm enrolment within the next working day from the receipt of the email with the enrolment documents.** Candidates who do not send the above-mentioned documents and payment within the deadline will lose the possibility to proceed with enrolling with no exceptions whatsoever, and their seat will be assigned to the next candidate in the ranking list and according to the indications given by the Registrar's Office.

## 7 – ENROLMENT PROCEDURE AND NECESSARY DOCUMENTS

In order to be eligible for enrolment, admitted candidates must hand in an English language knowledge certification corresponding to the C1 level of the Common European Framework of Reference *CEFR*.

**Candidates must organize in order to obtain the certificate in time for enrolment. Candidates without the necessary certification will not be allowed to enroll and will lose their place in the International MD Program.**

Candidates who have studied entirely in the means of the English Language in their Secondary School or University/College for at least the last two years preceding enrolment, are exempted from presenting the above mentioned English Language certification.

Candidates who have completed the procedure for enrolment as indicated in point. 6 will receive a confirmation email from the Registrar's Office, with the details needed to close the enrolment procedure.

### 7.1 Students enrolling for the first time in an Italian University:

These students have to present the documentation listed below. This documentation can be either sent in by registered mail, or personally handed in and sealed in an envelope and within the deadline given in the confirmation mail.

- Enrolment Request Form
- English Language knowledge Certification (original copy)
- For students with an Italian Maturita': 'autocertificazione conseguita Maturità' (online form)
- For students with foreign high school diplomas: original Diploma/Certificate with verified translation into Italian and **DICHIARAZIONE DI VALORE** for foreign titles given by the local Italian diplomatic authorities (Italian Consulate/Italian Cultural Centre). This declaration must have the information on the evaluation system of Certificates in the Country where it was obtained (final score, minimum and maximum score that can be assigned)
- Signed Privacy statement forms
- Photocopy of a valid ID document (and permit to stay badge if Non-EU Citizen already residing in Italy)
- Copy of the codice fiscale badge for Italian Students – **\*\*\*Foreign students can request one at their local Italian Consulate or obtain it once in Italy\*\*\***

- 1 signed passport size photograph signed on its back

Candidates with any kind of permanent or temporary disability admitted to the degree course must make explicit request of support measures as envisaged by the *law n° 104 February 5, 1992*). Candidates with learning disabilities according to the law n°170 October 8, 2010 with the new regulation concerning *specific learning disabilities within the educational environment* can request the special terms envisaged the Ministerial Decree n. 5669, July12, 2011. **In order to present the request candidates must download the specific form available online with all attachments requested and send everything to [enrolment.imdprogram@univr.it](mailto:enrolment.imdprogram@univr.it)**

Documentation will not be accepted if sent via email or fax or in any different way than as specified above.

Preceding Career Evaluation Requests: Any student who wishes to ask for an evaluation of a preceding career may do so only after enrolment has been completed by downloading the specific form and handing it to the Registrar's office with all the necessary attachments and the revenue stamp.

## **8 – RESERVE LISTS**

At the deadline for online enrolment, a notice will be posted on the University website ([www.univr.it](http://www.univr.it)) indicating the number of places still available which can be assigned according to the procedure hereby described.

Starting from the first working day after the publishing of the number of available places, the Registrar will indicate the candidates who have been admitted to the online enrolment procedure according to the ranking order of the list. This information will be posted online. The newly admitted candidates will have to proceed with online enrollment by 3 pm of the third working day after the reopening of the rankings as per art.6. Should the admitted candidate fail to confirm online enrolment, his/her place will be considered free and assigned to the next successful candidate in the ranking list.

Candidates will be admitted and enrolled to the course until there are places available.

## **9 – TUITION FEES A.Y 2019/2020**

The yearly tuition fees for students enrolling to the A.Y 2019/2020 amount to euro 20.140,00 and can be divided into 3 installments:

- 1st installment: euro 6.940,00 to be paid upon enrolment
- 2nd installment: euro 6.600,00 deadline January 31, 2020
- 3rd Installment: euro 6.600,00 deadline March 31, 2020

The above indicated amounts include the euro 140 regional tax which is defined each year from the Lombardy Region Council. Any variation to this tax will be communicated once the Council's resolution has been confirmed.



## 11 – MISCELLANEOUS

For all other issues not mentioned in this translation of the competition regulation, reference is to the existing Italian laws. According to the law n. 241 of August 7, 1990, the Head of the Competition Procedure is Ms Paola Tedeschi.

The President of the Admission Competition and Supervision committee nominated as resolved by the Faculty Board Meeting on September 19, 2018, is prof. Massimo Clementi.
